Etiquette is a word that's often heard in relation to golf. But it's not just about manners.

The guidelines for good golf etiquette are what they are for several very important reasons: Many of them relate to the safety of golfers, many relate to pace of play (which helps keep the game enjoyable), and other rules of golf etiquette relate to maintaining the quality of the golf course.

- **Double par rule.** For example on par 4's if you haven't reached the green by 8 strokes...pick up your ball and place it on furthest edge of green. Then putt out.
- Play ready golf. Don't stand with playing partners while they hit....go to your own ball...keeping the pace is critical.
- You are allowed 5 minutes to look for a lost ball.
- Mark your ball so that it is easily recognized. Playing the wrong ball costs you **2 strokes**
- The player who is furthest from the hole hits first.
- Play a provisional ball if you hit a ball that may be out of bounds or lost. Declare it first. If found, you **MUST** play 1st ball.
- Please be quiet while people are hitting or putting.
- No carts on tees or greens – pull and/or motorized.
