



OBGCC will be opening for the 2021 golf season on Thursday, April 22, 2021.

Premier Ford and the Ontario Government announced on April 7th that the province is going into a province-wide declaration of emergency and a stay-at-home order effective Thursday, April 8th, 2021. Included in this announcement is **confirmation that outdoor golf courses and driving ranges can open**. The following are the guidelines and procedures OBGCC will be following to be compliant and to ensure the safety of you, our members and our staff.

Tee times can be booked online at tee-on.com or by calling the Pro Shop at 905-476-5910 x111. Please do not leave messages for tee times, nor email a request.

- **Walk on's will not be permitted. Bookings must be pre-booked and paid online.**
- Tee times will be set every 10 minutes. For golfers playing 18 holes, before proceeding to the tee for your back 9, you will be required to check in with the greeter. PLEASE DO NOT GO DIRECTLY TO THE TEE.
- Foursomes are permitted.
- Please plan to arrive at the golf course only 20 minutes prior to your tee time. Upon your arrival at the golf course, you will be greeted by one of our staff who will confirm your tee time and review play procedures.
- Reservations for carts will not be available on on-line booking. Carts can be booked on arrival at the golf course based on availability. If you are sharing a power cart with someone that is **from a different household**, (bubbles are so last year) both MUST be wearing a mask while on the cart. Proof of residency may be required. Dividers are also available upon request.
- Flag poles will remain in the cup and are **not to be removed or touched**.
- Ball washers, rakes, and benches have been removed from the golf course. Score cards will be given to players by the greeter or at the Pro Shop window.
- On completion of your round, please return your golf cart to the designated area, remove your garbage and personal belongings, return to your car and travel safely home. While the stay-at-home order is in effect, no gathering around the clubhouse or parking lot is permitted.

- The Clubhouse (pro shop, kitchen and dining areas – inside and outside) is closed except for the washrooms on the lower level. Access to the washrooms will be via the lower door on the parking lot side of the building. Washrooms on the golf course will be available, effective May 1st. We will disinfect washrooms frequently. Should entry into the Pro Shop be required, a maximum of 2 customers is permitted and masks will be mandatory. Please restrict your access to the washroom facilities only.
- The kitchen will not open at this time. Sundry items will be available and canned beer and coolers only will be available for purchase at the Pro Shop window. Any transactions required, ie: purchase of golf balls, tees, etc. beverages or payment of power carts will be done via the window adjacent to the pro shop door. **Preferred payment accepted will be debit or credit.**
- Physical distancing practices must be adhered to at all times. All players & staff must stay at least 6-feet apart. If you are unable to do this, a mask must be worn.

Please remember...these are Provincial regulations, not Club regulations. We are following the compliance guidelines as set out by the Province of Ontario and Health Department. Most importantly, we are excited to be able to get you out and playing. It is most important that we protect the health and safety of our staff and YOU!

Leagues Play as follows:

Shot gun play is not permitted. Tee times will be reserved through your league convener.

Tee times have been reserved on the tee sheet for your leagues as follows:

Monday Morning Ladies League – Tee times begin at 8 am

Kesrock Ladies Golf League – Tee times begin Monday's at 3:00 pm

Wednesday Morning Seniors – Tee times begin at 9 am

Kesrock Men – Tee times begin at Wednesday's at 3:30 pm

Thursday Night Men – Tee times begin at 3 pm
